



POND/WETLAND/BASIN

PIPEWORK SYSTEM

- 1. DCWW ARE NOT ABLE TO ACCEPT LAND DRAINAGE OR
- 2. DCWW WILL NEED TO APPROVE THE CONSENT ORDER ISSUED FOR THE POND/WETLAND/BASIN BY THE MAINTAINING AUTHORITY
- 3. DCWW WOULD EXPECT THE POND/WETLAND/BASIN TO BE MAINTAINED BY A RECOGNISED BODY SUCH AS A LOCAL AUTHORITY, HIGHWAY AUTHORITY, INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD
- 4. DCWW WILL NEED TO APPROVE SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS AND CALCULATIONS FOR TECHNICAL APPROVAL TO ENSURE THE POND/ WETLAND/BASIN HAS BEEN ADEQUATELY DESIGNED TO ACCOMMODATE THE FLOW FROM THE STORM SEWERS.
- 5. DCWW WILL CONSIDER ADOPTION OF THE SEWERS AND ANCILLARIES UP TO AND INCLUDING THE HEADWALL.
- 6. AN EASEMENT WILL BE REQUIRED FOR RIGHTS OF ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE TO THE PIPELINE AND OUTFALL STRUCTURE/ POND/WETLAND/BASIN AND ITS PERIPHERY.
- 7. DISCHARGE FOR THE POND/WETLAND/BASIN IS EXPECTED TO GO TO A WATERCOURSE MAINTAINED BY RIPARIAN OWNER OR LOCAL AUTHORITY, HIGHWAY AUTHORITY, INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD, ENVIRONMENT AGENCY. THE FLOW CONTROL AND ITS STRUCTURE IS CONSIDERED PART OF THE POND/WETLAND/BASIN.
- 8. THIS DRAWING HAS BEEN PRODUCED BY THE SUDS WORKING PARTY FOR WALES AND IS INTENDED ONLY TO PROVIDE AN ILLUSTRATION OF A TYPICAL SITUATION AND HOW ADOPTION MAY BE VIEWED. THE DEVELOPER IS ADVISED TO LIASE WITH THE RELEVANT AUTHORITY REGARDING THE SITE SPECIFIC
